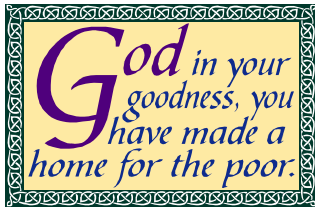

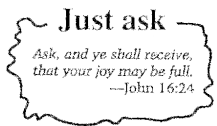

This group meets every week on Saturday at 8:30am in the teachers' lounge. Centering prayer is a very traditional prayer that has been prominent since the days of the early Church. During the time of the reformation, this method of prayer was lost except in the monasteries. It was during the 1960's and 70's that the people's hunger for deeper prayer brought about a revival for the common people. The basis of Centering Prayer is to be receptive and open to a closer relationship with God/Jesus.
